

WEST NOTTINGHAM PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Applicant must be a confirmed active participating member of West Nottingham Presbyterian Church. This is defined, in accordance with the Book of Order, as a person who "has made a profession of faith in Christ, has been baptized, has been received into membership of the church, has voluntarily submitted to the government of this church, and participates in the church's work and worship." [G-5.0202]

Applicants must be accepted by an institute of higher/further learning/training (two or four year college, trade school).

Scholarships will be awarded for undergraduate education only and are due by May 13, 2018.

Decisions on division of available scholarship money will be made in May of each year. Applicants will be notified in writing of any financial scholarship award from WNPC as soon as the decisions have been made, but no later than May 30.

Checks will be disbursed the last week of May, directly to the school that the applicant will attend. Applicant is responsible for providing the name and correct address for the Finance Office of the school that the applicant will attend. This information should be provided on the application. No money will be disbursed directly to the student.

Applicants may reapply annually for up to four consecutive years of their educational career, regardless of full or part time status.

The Mission Committee of Session will make the awards. Awards will be made on the Committee's assessment of need and/or standing of the applicant. Awards made to one student may not necessarily be of an equal amount as those made to another student. Submission of an application does not guarantee a scholarship award. All communications between the Mission Committee and applicants will be confidential.

An interview may be required if the Committee feels that it is necessary for their decision making process.

There will be no discrimination based on age, gender, GPA, intended course of study, or type of school to be attended.

This form must be returned with the applicant's signature below by the announced due date for the Mission Committee to consider the application. There will be no exceptions.

I have read and understood the guidelines, and I will abide by the decision of the Church and Community Mission Committee.
